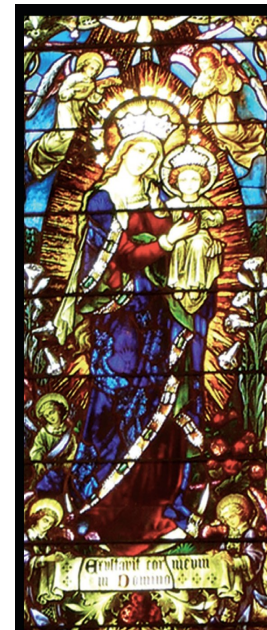

The Missionaries of the Sacred (MSC) founded the parish of Our Lady of the Sacred Heart in 1885, and St Margaret Mary's (SMM) in 1962.

Founded in 1854 in Issoudun, France by Fr Jules Chevalier, the MSC Mission is to help people experience God's loving presence in their lives and to extend that love to others, especially the poor and those who have yet to hear the Gospel.

Our Lady of the Sacred Heart is the special title of Mary, given to her by Fr Chevalier and promulgated by the MSC worldwide.

Randwick is the site of the National Shrine of O.L.S.H. and the Thursday Novena draws many to Our Lady of the Sacred Heart, **"the hope of the hopeless"**, seeking her intercession, consolation and guidance.

The Shrine is to the left of the sanctuary and you are welcome to leave your prayer petitions and letters of thanksgiving in the box provided.
