

### 125 Years Celebration of the Parish and Shrine of Our Lady of the Sacred Heart:

As we approach the Masses to close our 125 years celebrations, there is a litany of saints to thank. There has been quite an army of workers in the Church cleaning high and low – with the more difficult ascents to the heights, cleaning light shades, dusting arches etc undertaken by the Young Adults members. It has been a thorough cleaning involving the Altar Society, flower power, cleaners, candle cleaners etc. Thank you for your time in making our beautiful Church sparkle for our worship.

Choirs: a huge effort, as always, goes into each of the Masses via our musicians and singers, readers and acolytes – with special mention of the Family Mass – so attractive, and the combined choirs who have been practicing for 8 weeks for the Midday Mass. On Thursday evening last we combined with the Lurline Orchestra, founded by the Lindsay sisters, Maria and Angela, for the Schubert *Mass in G*. I pray it will be a truly uplifting foray into the Latin classical/romantic period. The celebrant is Bishop Brady, who returned from Rome on Saturday night beforehand.

Thanks to the various groups who have organized breakfast, wine and cheese, barbeques etc after each Mass. Special thanks to Kenji, Ronny and Rocco and the band of workers from the Young Adults who have also doubled as parking attendants and security! It is a joy to have them around.

Thanks to Tony McNamara the editor, and Debbie Lazenby for the design, and all who contributed to the *Parish Magazine* - a fitting commemoration of this jubilee year.

**The Presbytery Display:** thanks to Fr Patrick Sharpe MSC for the beautifully displayed ancient and new vestments – we have a treasury of artistic needle work, often originating in the Benedictine Sisters' Abbey from the turn of the 19<sup>th</sup> Century. They are priceless and I doubt their likes will ever be made again. Thanks to Annette Marskell for providing the display holders from the Cathedral for the vestments. Also, our thanks to the band of cleaners who polished up our beautiful monstrances, chalices, reliquaries etc. These items are priceless and not to be missed.

**Don't Miss This:** After you have sampled the food, come on in to the Presbytery and see these treasures of our parish –especially the Monstrance – one of three in the entire world made in Marseilles.

As we thank God for the richness of the past 125 years, let us, under the care and patronage of Our Lady of the Sacred Heart, do all that we can to continue that heritage as vibrantly as we can in our day.

This is a celebration of *special significance as the cause for the beatification of Fr Jules Chevalier, founder of the MSC and OLSH, has been opened after long and tedious delays, in Bourges, France*. The anniversary of Fr Chevalier's death is 21 October (1907), having seen his fledgling order expelled from their houses, and himself expelled as an elderly, frail man, he too was expelled from his presbytery a few months before his death. By that time his order has spread to 10 or so countries and numbered 800. "The seed that dies and falls into the ground, yields a rich harvest."

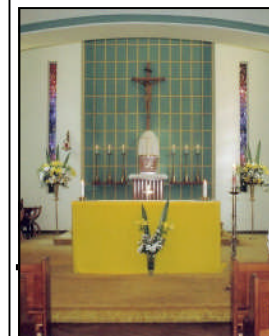
