

Spring time greetings now, hopefully, that the cold snap has passed.

The BIG NEWS is that we will begin with the NEW TRANSLATION OF THE MASS on ALL SOULS DAY, November 2nd at both SMM and OLSH. We were told that our new Missals for the Altar and celebrants had been posted, but no sign of them as yet...

PEW CARDS: we have around 400 of these, a gift of the Archdiocese. They are cunningly formatted – too big to fit into a hand bag – but, alas, too large for our hymn book holders. So, for the present they will repose at the end of each seat. PLEASE LEAVE THEM THERE (in a neat little pile). The Green Books with all the Eucharistic Prayers in them are available for \$3.00. I recommend that daily Mass goers buy one – available in the foyer.

WHAT TO BE ALERT FOR:

The Lord be with you. “AND WITH YOUR SPIRIT” – this is the main one to get used to.

INTRODUCTORY RITES:

The “I confess” is quite different. Lord have Mercy is unchanged.

GLORIA is slightly changed.

GOSPEL: A Reading from the Holy Gospel according to... GLORY TO YOU, O LORD.

CREED: Has the most changes: eg. I believe... CONSUBSTANTIAL WITH THE FATHER...

Liturgy of the EUCHARIST:

Invitation at the Offertory: Pray brothers and sisters... MAY THE LORD ACCEPT THE SACRIFICE...AND THE GOOD OF ALL HIS HOLY CHURCH.

ACCLAMATION OF FAITH: we will use, for the first two weeks the SECOND EUCHARISTIC PRAYER and the SECOND ACCLAMATION, as it is nearest the one we currently sing: When we eat this Bread and drink this Cup, we proclaim you Death, O Lord, UNTIL YOU COME AGAIN. (leave off the present “in glory”)

Lamb of God – unchanged.

Major change: LORD, I AM NOT WORTHY THAT YOU SHOULD ENTER UNDER MY ROOF, BUT ONLY SAY THE WORD AND MY SOUL SHALL BE HEALED.

In Past Bulletins I have endeavoured to give some background to these changes: too long ago, perhaps to recall. You may recall, however, the two principles for translation: Dynamic equivalence, which was the guiding idea for the present text – to have the Latin translation near to current spoken language. Formal equivalence: stick closer to the Latin – even to retaining the word “consubstantial” in the Creed to capture the uniqueness of Christ’s person; and “Lord I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof...” is a direct translation of that beautiful passage in Mt 8:5-13; Lk 7:1-10 which is the Roman Centurion’s statement to Jesus’ offer to come and heal his servant.

Next week, I will return in greater detail to some aspects of the New Mass Translation to refresh our memories. It is the celebrants who will have the most to adjust to! PHMSC



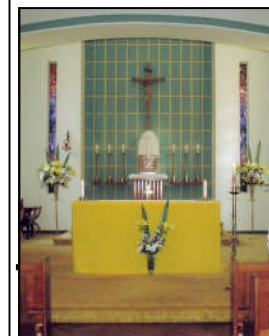
