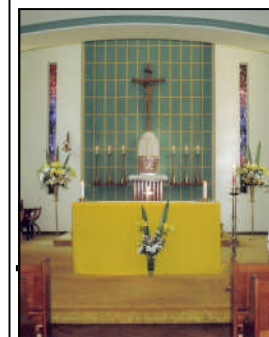

WORLD MISSION SUNDAY: This year the
focus is on world Indigenous Communities. As it
turns out the two countries nominated, Guatemala
and Australia have long connections with the
MSC and OLSH. In Australia, MSC-OLSH
founded at least 7 Aboriginal Catholic communi-
ties, many of which are now townships. There
they provided the first education, training and
health care ever for these nomadic people. In
Guatemala, the MSC stood up for the impover-
ished Mesquito Indians as international oil com-
panies with the aid of armed militia endeavoured
to dispossess them and take over their lands. Four
MSC were murdered, now known as the MSC
Martyrs of Guatemala. The Bishop ordered the
remaining 15 to leave that region as all were
given death threats. That was in the 1980s. As far
as I know, no one has been brought to justice for
these acts – furthermore, hundreds of local people
were murdered – school teachers, community
organisers, worker advocates, all in the name of
national "progress" masquerading as greed by the
few. Time changes but the times don't seem to
change much? I commend this Appeal to you all.
