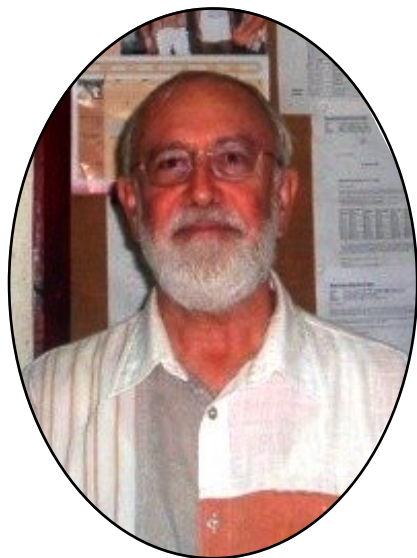

SEA FARERS APPEAL:

Each Year we send around \$3,000 for this important ministry and if you wish to add to that, see the priest after each Mass and we will send it off to the Stella Maris Centre. (My understanding is that we are one of a very few parishes which support this ministry.) 90% of Australia's trade relies on shipping which in turn is reliant on seafarers of whom there are about 1,000,000 on the oceans at any one time. Sea workers suffer isolation from families, far too often poor and dangerous working conditions, mental health issues because of isolation and poor treatment, dangers like piracy. Peter Hearn MSC
