

## Cana Communities:

**This year Cana is 44 years old.** For all those years VOLUNTEERS have built a community which creates relationships with- and companions people who are lonely, homeless, suffering from mental ill health or other factors which marginalise them from mainstream society.

**Cana operates 4 residential houses and 3 emergency overnight shelters in the city and for the last 4 years has leased a farm at Orchard Hills near Penrith.**

**At the Farm,** Cana gives marginalized people the opportunity to enter an environment of clean air and a hard day of work, which some have never experienced before.

Cana provides extensive counselling and companions each person who comes to the Farm. He or She is then offered the opportunity to engage in vocational training, work place readiness and education programs provided by TAFE Western Sydney. In addition, where possible Cana provides paid employment as a precursor to hopefully one day engaging with the outside world with full time paid employment! **The Cana Farm changes lives.**

**One of the residential houses is NAGLE HOUSE.** This is a transitional home for women. From opening the doors in July 2012, Nagle House has offered a safe home to 47 women. The women may have come from prison, a rehabilitation centre or living on the streets.

The volunteers at Nagle house work with each woman with care and understanding as they try to move from one phase of life to the next. One resident, Cris, moved out of Nagle House into public housing several months ago and has maintained a strong contact with Cana. She comes back to Nagle House to visit and one volunteer has continued to support her. After a visit with her young daughter, whom she had not seen in 4 years, Cris sent photographs and a message which said: "Thanks for all your support!! It really means a lot."

**Cana Communities does not receive any government funding.** Cana relies on donations from individuals and groups to continue the work. It is thanks to the generosity of our parishioners that Cana is able to continue the work.

As Cana is run by 700 volunteers, Cana is able to use all funds raised directly for the benefit of the people in need.
