

### **PRE-MSC HISTORY OF OLSH PARISH:**

The NSW Government had made land grants for various Churches in the Randwick area. The Catholics at the time were under the care of the Franciscans at Waverley who arrived in 1876. The original Government grant for a Catholic Church was on both sides of the corner where Chapel St enters Frenchman's Rd. It was considered to be not central enough to the developing town of Randwick. So they were sold by the Franciscans and the present site was bought (excluding the Ventnor area – which was the home of the Mayor of Randwick). The Franciscans had a brick Church-School built here, dedicated to Our Lady of Mercy. It was completed for the beginning of the school year of 1881. The presence of Randwick Race Course meant that more people began to live in this area. With the arrival of the MSC in 1885, (expelled from France in 1880), and the inability of the Franciscans to staff this area, Cardinal Moran gave what was till then a Mass Station of the Franciscan District, to the MSC who promptly renamed it Our Lady of the Sacred Heart. Almost immediately they began plans for a new church – the present one, and presbytery – the first of three on this site, the present one built in 1963. In the absence of a residence, three priests and two brothers-seminarians, (with the exception of Fr Tierney, an Irishman, all were French-speaking and destined for the Missions of Kiribati, PNG and Rabaul) rented in Napper Terrace, a building immediately next to our Church.
