Reports: SMM School – enrolment 198, new programs – Mathematics and Scientific Research, robotics (!), update on previous REC, Emily Fitzpatrick working in Uganda as a volunteer for this year...; Parent Educator: focusing on Fathers and attract ting them for involvement in the school, focus on well-being for children, support of parents in times of illness. **OLSH School** – Mrs Antoinette Harvey is our new Principal and feels very welcome; 416 children; updating RE curriculum, quality literacy working in with SMM, gifted education in mathematics with a support officer in the classroom from Year 2 onwards; wellbeing – increase in anxiety among students and some parents, Positive behavior for learning program, and circle solution process for class discussions, special needs students requirements. Family Educator: Stop, Pray and Reflect for parents under way, may introduced Toddler Tales to Parents with Prams in the Cloister Room Friday mornings, teaches music one day in week and developing school choir especially a boys' choir. Other **Reports: Young Adults** – weekly Lenten group going well, some new recruits; **Youth group** – one gathering per month with exciting activities, followed by Saturday night Mass at which they lead the singing, reading and collecting etc; Planning for major day-outing during school holidays. **Seniors:** monthly gatherings with morning tea and speakers in Cloister Room for men and women on different days; Lenten Group; monthly Clean Water Luncheon, Gentle Exercise, monthly movie afternoon; **Government Schools Catechetics** underway in both schools; **Liturgy Committee** to meet for Holy Week; Holy Spirit Prayer Group Choir formed for Sundays 10.00am once a month; **Visitation** of former parishioners outside parish has begun – a team of 25 visit 4 times annually, retreat day at Jamberoo Abbey, professional standards and in-service once a year, Mass and meal twice annually as a group; **RCIA:** 13 candidates plus three for Confirmation this year; **next intake begins 1st July.** **Parish 2020** – survey finishes this weekend **Building and Finance Report:** transept work going well, SMM needs two more speakers for sound system at back of Church, update on second collection and how it is tracking will be available for next PPC meeting.
