So no need to sit at home wondering what to do, or after your shopping, or visiting the TAB in the world centre of racing, and footy and...just come along and be still with the Lord. 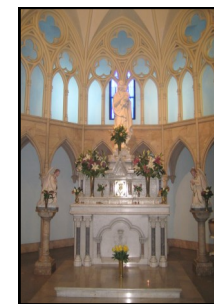
