St Francis de Sales on anxiety: A number of people asked me for a copy of the quotations I read from St Francis de Sales last weekend at some Masses. **Francis had suffered considerably from anxiety** at one stage, and his reflections on it are still valuable for our spirituality of the Heart:

“Do not look **forward** to what **may happen tomorrow**; the same everlasting Father of Jesus, who cares for you today will take care of you tomorrow and every day. Either He will shield you from suffering, or He will give you unflinching strength to bear it. Be at peace, then, put aside all anxious thoughts and imaginations, and say continually: 'The Lord is my strength and my shield; my heart has trusted in Him and I am helped. He is with me and in me and I with Him.'
