THANKS to so many people who accompanied Fr Doug Smith through the last week of his life – this only became fully apparent to me at the Sharing of Memories on Thursday evening at the Monastery Chapel, Kensington. Katie, his beloved niece was overwhelmed by the people who came to be with Fr Doug in the Liverpool Hospital: Marriage Encounter friends from his many years involved with that group, some coming from interstate; parishioners from SMM, OLSH and Coogee, and friends he made in various places over the years, together with family members. A teacher from OLSH read out some of the farewell remembrances of the Year 4 children – so touching and heartfelt for what Fr had been and done for them – all so positive. Many MSC confreres also spent time with him at Liverpool, including Fr Tru. It cannot be said of Fr Doug Smith, as Shakespeare has one of his characters exclaim: "The good we do if oft interred with their bones." (Julius Caesar, Act 3) His memory will gently live on. The Mass was very well- attended with 22 or so priests, mainly MSC. Fr Steve Dives, the assistant to the Provincial who was overseas at the time, was principal celebration, and Fr Peter Malone, a class mate of his from Chevalier College school days gave the homily.
