How can we ensure that we are praying and worshipping God in ways that are worthy and welcoming?

How care for those on the margins?

Form and support for Vocations, marital, priestly and religious vocations (lay single people are always left out in this line up....)

Strengthen Catholic identity and mission of key Catholic agencies?
