For many years parishioners have home-visited and transported those less mobile to mass and prayer groups, which continues today. Additionally, over the past 7-8 years the visitations have extended to many other facilities.

Tonight we give thanks for those who have invited us to their homes, cells, courtroom or hospital beds, in dying moments and times when they were at their most vulnerable. They have welcomed and prayed with us, blessing us with their trust. We thank Fr Peter Carroll msc, (restorative justice) the Daughters of OLSH, The Little Sisters of The Poor, Sr Nancy Fitzgerald rscj, the dedicated staff of the nursing homes and our own parish office who co-ordinate and frequently debrief our visits, enabling and supporting us to achieve this sacred task.

A letter from the Provincial of the Missionaries of the Sacred Heart—Australia.

Last Tuesday, 23rd October, 2018 the Prime Minister and the Parliament will offer a formal National Apology to people who have been harmed and affected by the tragedy, grief and horror of institutional child sexual abuse.

On behalf of the Province, and with contrition, I say sorry to every person who was harmed actually or vicariously-by any person formally associated with the Missionaries of the Sacred Heart.

To the people who sought and were entitled to safety in our care, yet found danger and neglect, I say sorry.

To those who have lost their faith as a result of the behaviour of one of our members, I say sorry.

To the people who have spent many years blaming themselves for the despicable actions of one of our men, I say sorry.

I say sorry because we did not take the responsibility when it was our duty to do so.

We now live in a post-Royal Commission Australia. We, the Missionaries of the Sacred Heart, thank the Commission of its diligence and determination. The Commission's findings have shone a welcomed and necessary light on us. Through this tragedy our awareness, our understanding and our compassion challenges all of us to a commitment that this tragedy may never recur.

As a Missionary of the Sacred Heart and leader of this Province, I am personally saddened and ashamed of our past history with regard to this issue, and of the failure of the Institutional Church to which I have dedicated my life.

I hereby commit to ensure that the human and systemic failures of the past that have enabled child sexual abuse in our Province to occur, are resolved; permanently and irreversibly. I am determined the Province will learn from its past and use that learning to be a leading exponent of child-safe practice across our Province, becoming the safe institution we were commissioned to be, and always should be: To be men whose mission is to be on earth the Heart of God.
