

## CHILD PROTECTION WEEK:

The following is taken from the notes for this Sunday from the Archdiocesan Safeguarding Team. "All of our work is guided by the 10 Child Safe Standards issues by the Royal Commission into Institutional Responses to Child Sexual Abuse and the National Catholic Safeguarding Standards being developed by Catholic Professional Standards Ltd. The Poster (in foyer and summarized below) and post cards (also in foyer and summarized below) meet the following core components of Standards 2, 4 and 6 of the Child Safe Standards, those being:

### Standard 2: Children participate in decisions affecting them and are taken seriously.

Children are able to express views and re provided opportunities in decisions that affect their lives.

### Standard 4: Equity is upheld and diverse needs re taken into account.

All children have access to information, support and complaints processes.

### Standard 6: Processes to respond to complaints of child sexual abuse are child focused.

(a) The institution has a child-focused complaint-handling system that is understood by children, staff, volunteers and families.

The informs children and young people about what child abuse is, their right as a child and young person to be safe from abuse and how to seek help from a trusted adult. These Safeguarding Journey Poster is part of the ...**OFFICE'S EXISTING SUITE OF CHILD FRIENDLY DOCUMENTS AND RESOURCES, TO HELP KEEP CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE INFORMED AND SAFE IN OUR** Archdiocese.

**The Safeguarding Journey Poster has 8 "stops":** 1. "I will respect myself and other people". 2. "I decide if people can take my photos". 3. "If someone asks me to do something that scared me or that I don't like, I have the right to say no." 4. "I do not talk to or meet up with strangers". 5. "I want to be heard by a trusted adult". 6. "I do not keep secrets about bad things which are happening to me or to someone else". 7. "If I see something I don't like I will tell an adult". 8. "If I get bullied I will talk to someone I can trust."

The **Someone Will Listen to You Postcards** has been developed to inform children that **"Someone will listen to you if the feel scared, curious, embarrassed, sad or worried": "Tell an adult you trust – a parent, aunty, teacher or an older brother or sister so they can help you."** It also prompts the children and young people of the Archdiocese of Sydney to **think of their three most trusted adults.** The Postcard also forms part of the Safeguarding...Office's existing suite of child friendly documents and resources.
