

CATECHISTS for the government schools:

This is a crucial apostolate for our parish. There are over 200 children in the two government Primary Schools within the Parish. Maybe the only time they will hear about our Christian Life will be through a catechist.

Class times:

Randwick Public School, Cowper St. Wednesdays 1:40 - 2:50 PM

Rainbow Public School, Rainbow St. Thursdays 9 - 10 AM

Classes are for a half an hour.

(A separate group will provide classes for Randwick Boys' and Girls' High Schools)

Training: catechists are given a thorough training by the Confraternity for Christian Doctrine (CCD), from the Archdiocese of Sydney.

Class-room Program: Children and Catechists follow a set program which is laid out step by step, minute by minute. (You end up with about 20 mins of teaching time.)

Before you can teach, you will need to have completed a Level 1 Certificate Course. On-going courses are to Level 5.

You will need a **Working With Children Check #**.

We will have our Catechists' Sunday on 16 February, focused at the Midday mass with a lunch to follow for our Catechists and interested people.
